HAS YOUR CHILD RECENTLY BEEN DIAGNOSED WITH AUTISM?

We are recruiting parents to participate in the STAND parent training group as part of the STAND study! The goal of the STAND program is to support families in understanding their child's new diagnosis and feeling confident in their next steps.

PARTICIPATION INCLUDES:

- All study activities are virtual
- Participate in 8 weekly STAND session (1 hours each) with 3-6 other parents and a facilitator.
- Receive the STAND workbook (worksheets, information, referrals)
- Participants will be placed in either the immediate start group or the delayed start group.
- Complete data collections (survey and brief interview) before and after STAND program. (\$20 compensation provided for each data collection)
